Our Values

At Young Friends, sustainability is not an add-on — it's embedded in every decision we make. Our use of washable cloth nappies is a core part of our environmental responsibility, as well as a practical, respectful approach to care.

- Sustainability Reducing landfill waste, plastic use, and unnecessary consumption
- Respect Gentle on skin, developmentally appropriate, and consistent across home and nursery
- Authenticity Not greenwashing real systems, real routines, real change
- Supportive Leadership Staff are trained, confident and calm in reusable nappy care
- Community Families are supported, not judged, in our cloth nappy journey

Policy Statement

Young Friends provides a full cloth nappy service as part of our paid extras package. This includes:

- · High-quality, washable cloth nappies
- Reusable wipes
- · In-house laundering using natural, child-safe products
- · Ongoing monitoring of nappy comfort, hygiene and fit
- · Advice and support for parents wanting to use cloth at home

Why We Do This

We estimate that each child in disposable nappies produces **up to 1 tonne of waste** over their time in early years care. By choosing reusable nappies:

- We dramatically reduce our landfill contribution
- We avoid plastic waste and chemical exposure
- Children have a healthier, breathable nappy experience
- Staff become confident in an area that supports wider environmental learning
- Children are part of a setting where sustainability is modelled daily, not just talked about

How It Works in Practice

- Families opting into our extras package are automatically included in the cloth nappy system
- Each child has their own labelled set of nappies and wipes
- Used nappies are stored hygienically and laundered daily on site
- All nappies are washed at 60°C with eco detergent, line dried where possible
 Nappies are checked for wear and comfort and replaced as needed
 Staff are trained in:
 - Fitting and changing cloth nappies o Correct hygiene protocols
 - Responding sensitively to toileting signals and routines

Our Stance on Disposable Nappies

As part of our environmental commitment, we do not provide or accept disposable nappies at Young Friends. This is a conscious and responsible decision:

- We do not have an offensive waste collection service
- Disposables cannot be disposed of safely or sustainably on-site
- We take a leadership stance in climate-conscious early years practice
 - · All children in nappies are supported with our full cloth system
 - Where a documented medical exemption is in place, a personalised alternative may be agreed
- We ask all families to support this essential part of our ethos and values and we cannot be flexible unless the reason is medical.

Home Partnerships

- Parents are welcome to use their own reusable system from home (if preferred)
- We can offer guidance, support and reassurance
- We understand some families may still use disposables at home we work without judgement
 We use consistent language and support for toilet learning

Exclusions and Allergies

- If a child has a confirmed skin sensitivity or allergy to cloth materials, an alternative plan will be agreed with management
- Disposable wipes are not used unless medically required
